Pillars of Scouting

For the Silicon Valley Monterey Bay Council to continue to deliver the quality Scouting programs to our youth, three fundamental pillars must be sustained and increased: operating income, capital income and endowment income. Encouraging endowment gifts to our council is one of our highest priorities. It is one of the best ways to ensure that our council can continue to offer the outstanding programs it now has and also grow to meet the needs of the youth and communities we serve.

What is a council endowment?

The Silicon Valley Monterey Bay Council endowment fund is an investment fund in which a small percentage can be withdrawn annual and be used for the ongoing operations or other specified purposes. The Fund's primary investment mission in most circumstances is to preserve principal and purchasing power in real dollar terms over time, while supporting current income requirements.

The James E West Fellowship Award

James E West was the first Chief Scout Executive of the Boy Scouts of America, and he served in that position for more than three decades. The West Fellowship Award is available for gifts of \$1,000 and up in cash or marketable securities to our council endowment fund. The gift must be in addition to –
