V105 - Introduction to Leadership Skills for Crews (4 hours)	Leaders are required to communicate, make decisions, and delegate every day. This course will cover these core topics through thought provoking discussions and activities. We will also spend time highlighting the importance of creating a vision and setting goals. These are skills that remain relevant within Scouting and beyond. This course is a requirement for the Discovery Award for Venturers. 4-hour Class. V102 - Mentoring for Venturers (2 hours)	Who is your mentor? What, you don't have a mentor? What is mentor anyway? If you are a member of a Venturing Crew or a Venturing Advisor, you need to come to Mentoring for Venturers to learn what a mentor is and how you can be an effective mentor. Anyone who has held a leadership position is the perfect candidate to pass the skills you have learned onto your successor(s). This training will make you an effective mentor, both in Venturing and in your personal life.
