News Anchor at KSBW Action News 8

Dan Green is a favorite of Central Coast television viewers. He is anchor of the number-one rated KSBW Action News 8 broadcasts at five, six and eleven.

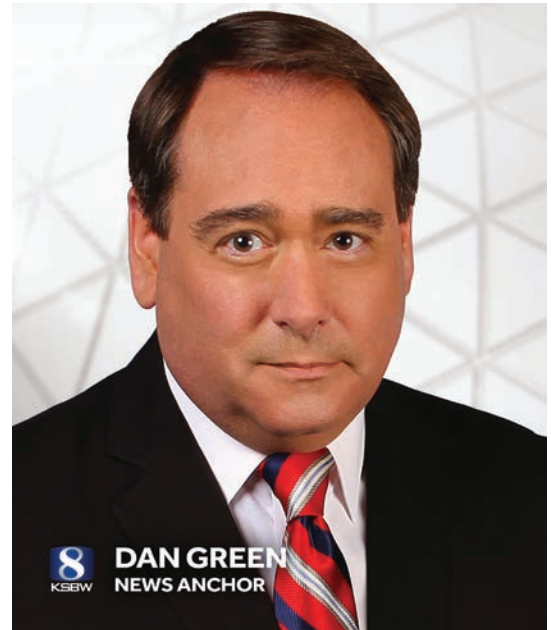
Best known for his coverage of breaking news, specialty reporting and his humor, Dan continues to be honored year after year at KSBW-TV 8. He has been chosen as best male anchor each year in local viewer polls and honored with the highly-coveted Edward R. Murrow Award from the Radio and Television News Directors Association for his popular "Animal Stories" feature.

A lifetime broadcast veteran, Dan has extensive experience in both television and radio. In radio he received countless wire service awards for breaking news coverage and was a member of the Peabody Award winning news team at KCBS-AM. He began his television career with KGO-TV in San Francisco by covering the 1989 Loma Prieta earthquake.

Following his reporting in San Francisco, he worked as a field producer for the ABC network. He later was named anchor and news director at KMIZ-TV in Columbia, Missouri, where he was honored three times with the Missouri Broadcaster's Association award for breaking news coverage.

In 1992, Dan returned to California, and created the Ventura County News Network, serving as both news director and main anchor. There he received an Edward R. Murrow Award for documentary television, an Emmy nomination for documentaries, and was named "Outstanding Young Man of the Year" in 1993.

Dan resides in Monterey with his wife and their two children.



KEYNOTE SPEAKER > Daniel W. Bursch

Retired US Navy Captain & Former NASA Astronaut

Daniel W. Bursch was born July 25, 1957, in Bristol, Pennsylvania, but considers Vestal, New York, to be his hometown. Dan is married to Sharon Yencharis and they have four children and two grandchildren. His hobbies include woodworking and auto mechanics.

After graduating in 1975 from Vestal Senior High School, in Vestal, New York, Bursch attended the United States Naval Academy, where he studied physics. He graduated in 1979 with a Bachelor of Science degree in physics and was designated a naval flight officer in April 1980 at Pensacola, Florida.

After initial training as an A-6E Intruder bombardier/navigator (B/N), he reported to Attack Squadron 34 in January 1981, and deployed to the Mediterranean aboard the USS John F. Kennedy, and to the North Atlantic and Indian Oceans aboard the USS America. He attended the U.S. Naval Test Pilot School in January 1984. Upon graduation, he worked as a project test flight officer flying the A-6 Intruder until August 1985, when he returned to the U.S. Naval Test Pilot School as a flight instructor. In April 1987, Bursch was assigned to the Commander, Cruiser-Destroyer Group 1, as Strike Operations Officer, making deployments to the Indian Ocean aboard the USS Long Beach and the USS Midway. Redesignated an Aeronautical Engineering Duty officer (AEDO), he attended the Naval Postgraduate School in Monterey, California, from July 1989 until his selection to the astronaut program.

During this time, he continued his formal education and earned a Master of Science degree in engineering science from the Naval Postgraduate School in 1991. He was recognized as a Distinguished Graduate from the U.S. Naval Academy and U.S. Naval Test Pilot School.

Selected by NASA in January 1990, Bursch became an astronaut in July 1991. His technical assignments included: Astronaut Office Operations Development Branch, working on controls and displays for the Space Shuttle and Space Station; Chief of Astronaut Appearances; spacecraft communicator (CAPCOM) in mission control. A veteran of four space flights, Bursch has logged over 227 days in space. He was a mission specialist on STS-51 (1993), STS-68 (1994) and STS-77 (1996) and served as flight engineer on the International Space Station (ISS) Expedition-Four (2001-2002). Dan Bursch and fellow astronaut Carl Walz have one of the longest single flights for US astronauts: 196 days in space. In January 2003, Bursch reported to the Naval Postgraduate School in Monterey, CA for a two-year assignment as an instructor in the Space Systems Academic Group. In June 2004 he was appointed Associate Dean of the Graduate School of Engineering and Applied Sciences. Bursch retired from the Navy in July 2005 after 26 years of service. He then joined the Aerospace Corporation and served as the National Reconnaissance Office (NRO) Advisor at the Naval Postgraduate School in Monterey until his retirement in 2019.

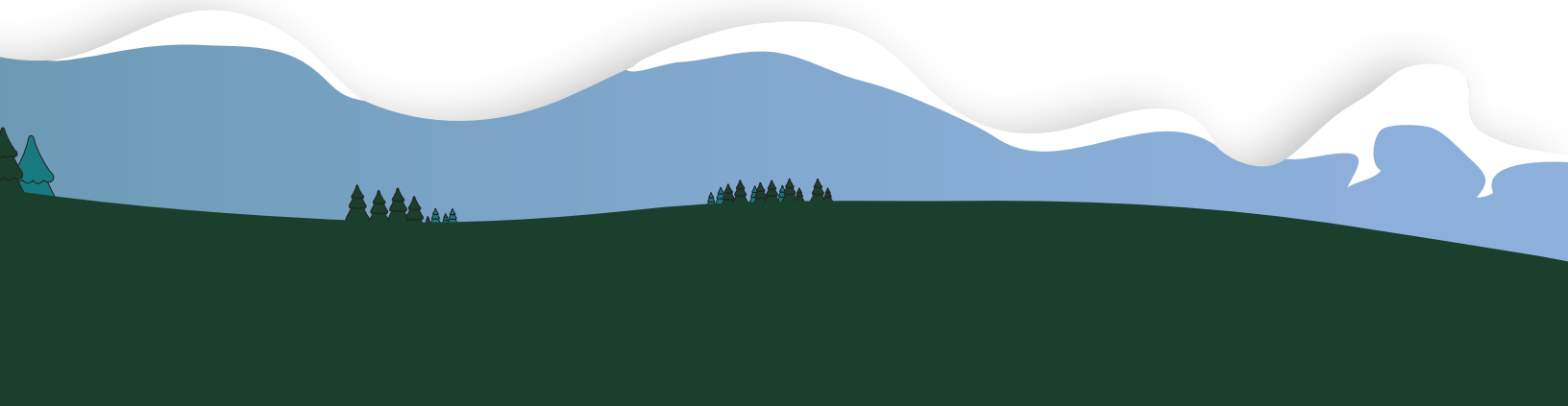

LIFESAVING RECOGNITIONS

Katherine Townsend

On October 1, 2018, Katherine Townsend was dining at a restaurant while on vacation with her children when an elderly man who was choking became unresponsive while receiving abdominal thrusts from fellow patrons. As a nurse who was trained in CPR, she quickly sprang into action, asked the manager to call 911, and then with the assistance of another patron, administered chest compressions after failed attempts to clear his airway with thrusts. She continued compressions until emergency medical services arrived and took over his care and transport to the hospital. With the man now with EMS, Katherine provided comforting words to his family and returned to her young children to assure them the gentleman was in good hands. Katherine is presented with the Council Certificate of Merit on February 26, 2022.

Brody Ballard

On July 3, 2020, 10-year-old Scout Brody Ballard was surfing with his father in Monterey Bay when he observed a young lifeguard attempting to rescue an 8-year-old girl who had been swept out in the strong current and wind. Without delay he paddled over to the struggling pair, and with the aid of his surfboard, rescued the girl from drowning, transporting her to shore. He reassured the girl while bringing her to shore while he also maintained communication with the lifeguard. Brody is presented with the Council Certificate of Merit on February 26, 2022.

Juergen Smith

On two occasions, June 22, 2021 and July 9, 2021, Juergen Smith provided lifesaving aid to his wife, Jody, who had experienced medical emergencies while home. On the morning of June 22nd, he found her unresponsive and not breathing. Juergen asked his daughter to call 911 while beginning CPR breaths and compressions. On the third set, Jody regained consciousness. She recovered after emergency medical services transported her to the hospital for treatment, which included an implanted heart monitor device. On July 9th, Jody became unresponsive again and Juergen started CPR until EMS arrived. An AED was used and restored her pulse on the third shock. Her heart monitor captured the event and Jody now has a defibrillator implanted in her chest. Juergen is presented with the Council Certificate of Merit on February 26, 2022.
