Decisions to Protect In 1890 the 5 General Grant National Parks were created. Giant sequoias included within their boundaries. Conservation management was placed on the land in 1893 when the Sierra Forest Preserve was established. The Sequoia National Forest was also established. In 1992 President George H.W. Bush made a proclamation to protect, manage and preserve the giant sequoias as unique objects of beauty and inspiration of all people.
